This symposium and workshop will focus on recent technological advances as they are applicable to Internet-based global education and its influence on the peoples of the world at large.

We suggest the following general topics for this symposium:

1. Globalization of education: could it lead to democratic enlightenment or be misused for fanatic indoctrination?
2. The psychological effects of new technologies on education.
3. Knowledge transfer in a global educational system and potential impact on the diversity of cultures.
4. Global education in social context.
5. Solutions to global problems through world-wide education
6. Legal aspects of a global educational network.
7. The potential impact of world-wide education on political systems.
8. Can global learning lead from a culture of war to a culture of peace?
9. Assault on academic freedom of expression: Academic governance by decree or by consent?
10. Democracy under attack: How can we prevent dictatorship through global education?

During the workshop, we will demonstrate how to create web applications “on the fly” without specific knowledge of html, xhtml, and/or Java, e.g. MS Expression Studio, MS Word, etc. We will explore Internet-based communication tools as aids in global education.
