Our Symposium has been continuous since Year 2000, and all the personally delivered papers up to 2009 have been peer-reviewed and published in G.E. Lasker and K. Hiwaki (eds.), *Sustainable Development and Global Community* (Volume I to Volume X), the International Institute for Advanced Studies in Systems Research and Cybernetics (IIAS).

As in the ten previous Symposia, we shall adhere to the definition of Sustainable Development adopted by the World Commission on Environment and Development in *Our Common Future* (1987) and the 2002 World Summit on Sustainable Development in Johannesburg, South Africa, in order to avoid definitional confusion. “Sustainable Development is development that meets the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs.” Also, Sustainable Development is a process of change in which the exploitation of resources, the direction of investment, the orientation of technological development, and institutional change are made consistent with future as well as present needs. Further, Sustainable Development is built on three interdependent and mutually reinforcing pillars – economic development, social development and environmental protection – which must be established at local, national, regional and global levels.

Interpreted consistently, we may simplify the definition, as follows:

Sustainable Development is a long-term process of well-balanced socioeconomic development (in each and every society) harmonious with the global environment.

In approach to our theme in the 11<sup>th</sup> International Symposium, you may relate to the following issues and subjects, among other things:

- Common future, culture of peace, human ethos, modern capitalism, value system, market system, diverse cultures, democracy, environment, resources, employment, consumption, investment, income distribution, international trade, paradigm shift, population explosion, mass media, government, NGO, business ethics, collaborative consciousness, decent lifestyle, educational innovation, cultural enrichment, human integrity, social solidarity,
